Collected together, these papers constitute an insightful overview of the progress in current knowledge of the Ancient Nubian past.

More than 60 papers presented during the sessions, as well as a record of two panel discussions on the languages of Nubia and the iconography of rulers and religious ceremony inside sacral buildings will be published in Part Two of the Proceedings.
